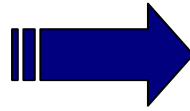


COLD CHAIN BREAKDOWN ACTION PLAN

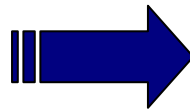


Melted ice bricks

from supplier



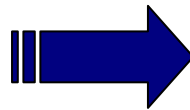
Keep vaccines in esky in

Monitor indicates
Vaccines froze or
warmed during
transport



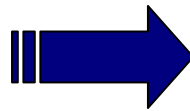
Keep vaccines in esky in
the fridge and contact the
supplier.

Vaccine fridge
thermometer
indicates vaccines
froze 0° or
reached $>15^{\circ}$



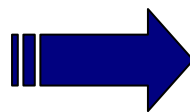
Isolate the affected
vaccines at 2 to 8° C. Do
not use or discard
vaccines until advice has
been sought and received
from RIC.

Power failure to
fridge for 4 hours
or less



Leave vaccines in fridge
with fridge door closed
until power restored.
Commence looking for
alternative storage
options. Contact RIC.

Fridge switched
off or power
failure for more
than for 4 hours



If vaccines are at risk of
heat damage use
alternative storage
arrangements. Do not
discard vaccines, contact
RIC
